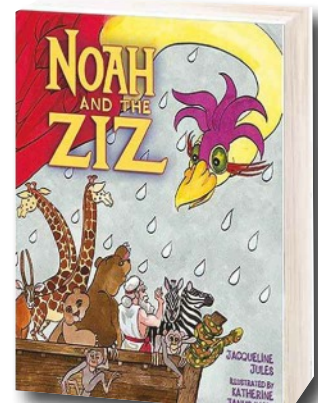

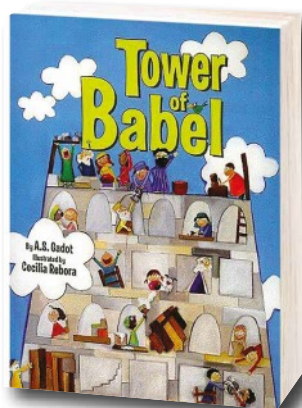

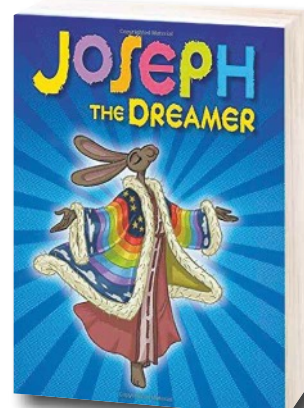
JOSEPH THE DREAMER

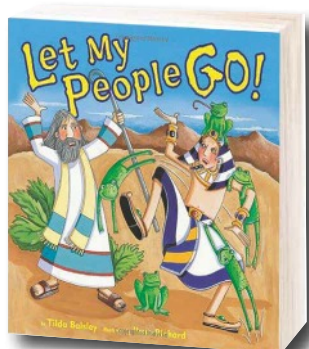

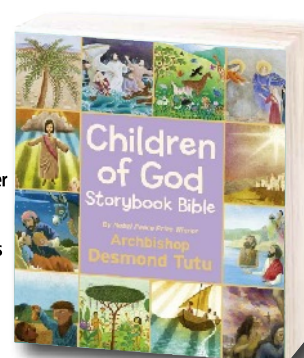
A beautiful book of illustrated Bible stories, retold by the world's best-loved cleric.
