

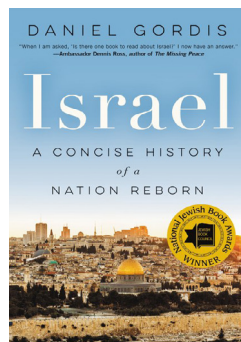

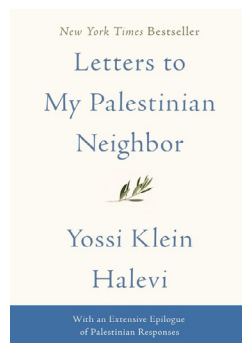


Israel: A Concise History of a Nation Reborn

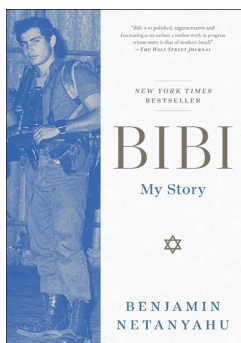


Letters to My Palestinian Neighbor

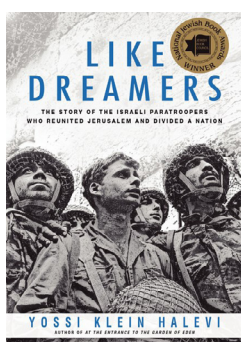
