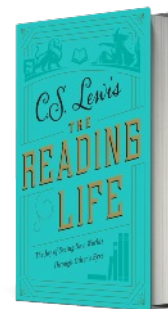

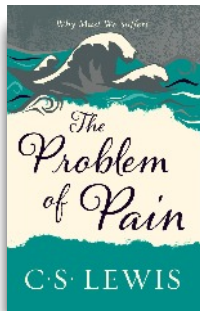
## THE PROBLEM OF PAIN

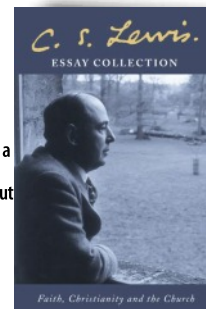

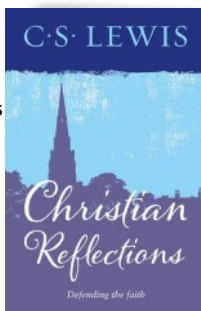

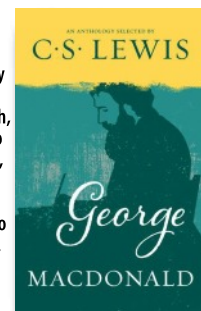
## GEORGE MACDONALD

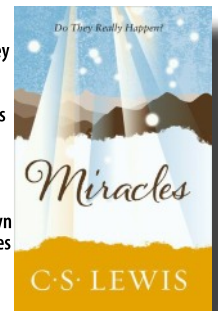
### MIRACLES

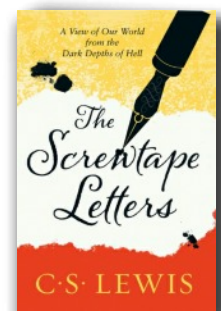


### THE SCREWTAPE LETTERS

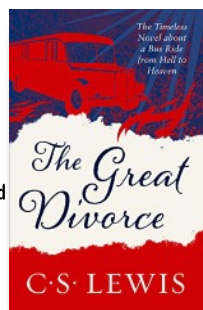


### THE GREAT DIVORCE

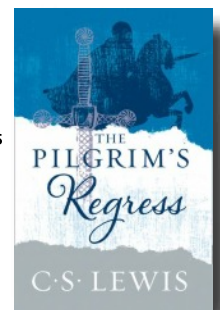


### THE PILGRIM'S PROGRESS

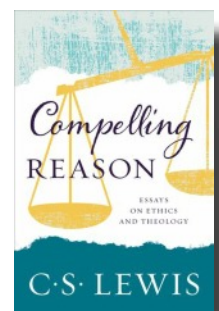
### COMPELLING REASON
