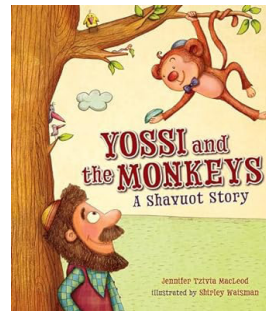

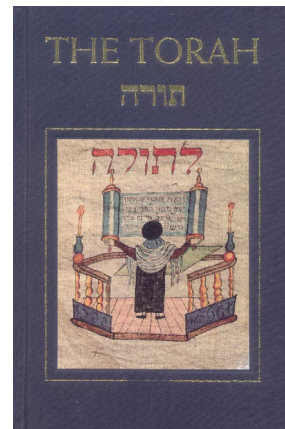


Yossi and the Monkeys A Shavuot Story By Jennifer Tzivia Macleod

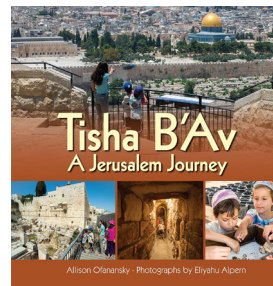
Bound in blue cloth with an illuminated gold foil front cover, this book is an ideal gift and would grace any home.
