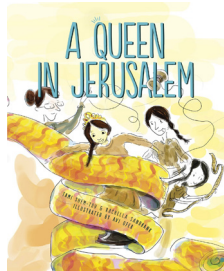

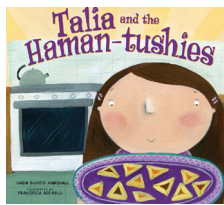

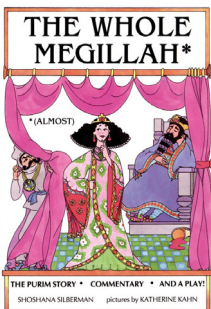


Talia and the Haman Tushies

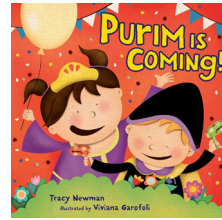
