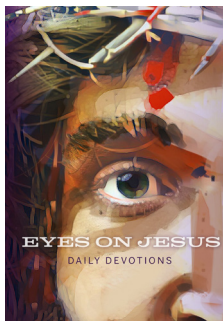


PRAYING WITH THE PSALMS

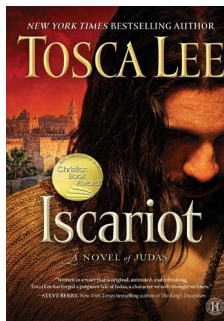
EYES ON JESUS
